SHERIFF HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING A DEPUTY INVOLVED SHOOTING AT NORMANDIE AVENUE AND 94TH PLACE, LOS ANGELES.

DEPUTY GONZALO GALVEZ AND DEPUTY DIANA FUNES DETAINED TWO SUSPECT MALES BELIEVED TO BE INVOLVED IN CRIMINAL ACTIVITY. DURING A CURSORY PAT-DOWN SEARCH, ONE OF THE SUSPECTS BEGAN TO RUN AWAY FROM THE DEPUTIES. BOTH DEPUTIES GAVE CHASE AND SAW THE SUBJECT REMOVE A HANDGUN FROM HIS WAIST AREA.

THE SUBJECT THEN RAN WEST ON 94TH STREET AND NORTH INTO THE ALLEYWAY BEHIND 9313 NORMANDIE AVENUE, WHERE HE TURNED TOWARD THE DEPUTIES AND FIRED ONE ROUND FROM HIS REVOLVER AT THEM. DEPUTY GALVEZ RETURNED FIRE, STRIKING THE SUBJECT IN THE UPPER LEG. THE SUBJECT COLLAPSED BETWEEN THE APARTMENTS AT 9307 AND 9313 NORMANDIE AVENUE.

THE SUBJECT WAS TRANSPORTED VIA AMBULANCE TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WHERE HE UNDERWENT SURGERY AND IS EXPECTED TO SURVIVE.

NO DEPUTIES WERE INJURED.

A LOADED .357 REVOLVER HANDGUN WAS RECOVERED AT THE SCENE.
