SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE SHOOTING DEATH OF A MALE BLACK ADULT THAT OCCURRED ON THE 1300 BLOCK OF WEST 109TH PLACE, LOS ANGELES.

DETECTIVES HAVE LEARNED A DARK COLORED VEHICLE, OCCUPIED BY ONE OR MORE MALE HISPANICS, DROVE UP TO WHERE THE VICTIM AND TWO OTHER MALE BLACK ADULTS WERE STANDING. A VERBAL ARGUMENT ENSUED BETWEEN THE SUSPECT(S) AND THE VICTIM. ONE SUSPECT SUBSEQUENTLY PRODUCED A HANDGUN AND FIRED AT THE VICTIM STRIKING HIM IN THE UPPER TORSO. THE SUSPECT VEHICLE CONTINUED EASTBOUND ON WEST 109TH PLACE AND OUT OF VIEW.

THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WHERE HE WAS PRONOUNCED DEAD.
