SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE DEPUTY INVOLVED HIT SHOOTING IN THE 3500 OF TEMPLE CITY BOULEVARD, ROSEMEAD.

DETECTIVES HAVE LEARNED THAT DEPUTIES RESPONDED TO A FAMILY DISTURBANCE AT A RESIDENCE WHERE THE FATHER HAD CALLED STATING THAT HIS SON WAS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS AND ARMED WITH A MACHETE. WHEN DEPUTIES ARRIVED, THEY RECEIVED INFORMATION THAT THE SUSPECT WAS NOW IN THE BACKYARD OF A NEARBY RESIDENCE, ARMED WITH A BASEBALL BAT AND A MACHETE. WHEN TWO DEPUTIES RESPONDED TO THE SUSPECT'S LOCATION, HE REFUSED TO DROP THE WEAPONS AND ADVANCED ON THE DEPUTIES. FEARING FOR THEIR SAFETY, BOTH DEPUTIES FIRED THEIR DUTY WEAPONS, STRIKING THE SUSPECT IN THE UPPER TORSO.

THE SUSPECT WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL, WHERE HIS CONDITION IS DESCRIBED AS CRITICAL.
