CORRECTION AND UPDATE

PRIOR TO A SHERIFF'S SPECIAL WEAPONS TEAM ENTERING THE MOTEL ROOM, A SHERIFF'S K-9 WAS DEPLOYED IN AN EFFORT TO GET THE SUSPECT TO SURRENDER. AFTER THERE WAS NO RESPONSE FROM GRAMMER, A SPECIAL WEAPONS TEAM ENTERED THE MOTEL ROOM AND FOUND THE SUSPECT UNCONSCIOUS WITH A PUNCTURE WOUND TO HIS CHEST. A FIREARM WAS RECOVERED.

THE SUSPECT WAS AIRLIFTED BY SHERIFF'S RESCUE HELICOPTER (AIR-5) TO A TRAUMA HOSPITAL. THE HOSPITAL DOCTOR REPORTS THAT THE WOUND TO THE SUSPECT'S CHEST WAS ACTUALLY A K-9 BITE THAT RESULTED IN A MINOR WOUND. THE SUSPECT REMAINS COMATOSE AND IS UNDERGOING TREATMENT BY MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS.

INITIAL REPORTS THAT THE SUSPECT HAD SUFFERED AN APPARENT SELF-INFLICTED GUNSHOT WOUND WERE INCORRECT. INSTEAD IT APPEARS THAT THE WOUND WAS FROM A K-9 BITE AND THE SUSPECT IS COMATOSE DUE TO THE POSSIBLE INGESTION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.
