NARRATIVE

On Wednesday, May 6th, at about 1:30 AM, a 50-year-old Rancho Palos Verdes couple was awakened by the sounds of someone breaking into their apartment. The husband walked into his living room where he was confronted by an armed, burglary suspect. The 17-year-old suspect stabbed him three times with a large, military knife before fleeing the apartment. Responding deputies from the Lomita Sheriff's Station soon located and arrested the dangerous suspect, who was still hiding inside the apartment complex.

The victim was transported to a nearby hospital where he is currently listed in stable condition. The 17-year-old suspect has since been linked to two additional burglaries and is now facing multiple felony charges including attempt murder, burglary and weapons violations. He is currently awaiting arraignment as an adult in South Bay Superior Court and being held without bail.
