- 4. Encourage students and their families to wear white or yellow for the march.**
- 5. Arrive at Woodcrest Elementary School's main yard no later than 8:00 a.m. for the march on Saturday, April 18, 2009.**
- 6. Be ready to shout to the top of your lungs for PEACE!**
