### EVACUATION UPDATE

**EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY**  
**February 6, 2010**  
**8:30 P.M.**

Based upon continued evaluation of the weather, the flood control systems and roadway access of the foothill communities, the Incident Commanders have lifted the mandatory evacuations for all of La Crescenta and Acton.

Mandatory evacuation orders have also been lifted for La Canada Flintridge with the exception of the Paradise Valley community, which remains evacuated. Evacuations still in place include:

- Ocean View Blvd. from 5524 and north
- Earnslow Drive
- Normanton Drive
- Bristow Drive
- Derwood Drive
- Manistee Drive
- Highrim Road

Incident Command has determined that ongoing mandatory evacuations in these areas are necessary based on active debris flow in the streets, affected public utility services, and damaged vehicles and material blocking access.

Incident Commanders will evaluate the remaining evacuation orders tomorrow, Sunday, February 7, at 10:00 a.m. Residents will be advised of all updates at that time.
