NARRATIVE: A motorist was involved in a traffic collision early this morning on the 110 Freeway, just north of the Adams Avenue exit. He got out of his car and began to walk on the freeway. Meanwhile, a Los Angeles County Sheriff's Deputy was traveling southbound in an unmarked county vehicle when he accidentally struck and fatally injured the man who walking on the freeway.

A second deputy, who was on his way to work in his personal vehicle, struck debris on the roadway related to the first traffic collision. The second deputy assisted the first deputy in attempting to render aid to the victim. Both deputies were transported to a local hospital for treatment of minor injuries.

The California Highway Patrol is conducting the traffic collision investigation.
