SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING A DEPUTY INVOLVED SHOOTING, WHICH OCCURRED SATURDAY, MARCH 06, 2010, AT THE INTERSECTION OF FIRESTONE BOULEVARD AND CALIFORNIA AVENUE, SOUTH GATE.

DETECTIVES HAVE LEARNED THAT WHILE ON ROUTINE PATROL, TWO CENTURY STATION SERGEANTS, OBSERVED THE OCCUPANTS OF ONE VEHICLE SHOOTING AT THE OCCUPANTS OF A SECOND VEHICLE WHICH CAUSED THE SECOND VEHICLE TO CRASH INTO A STREET LIGHT POLE. THE SUSPECTS IN THE FIRST VEHICLE CONTINUED TO SHOOT AT THE VICTIMS. AS THE SERGEANTS ATTEMPTED TO DETAIN THE SUSPECTS, ONE OF THE FOUR MALE HISPANIC ADULT SUSPECTS POINTED A FIREARM AT THEM. FEARING FOR THEIR LIVES, BOTH SERGEANTS FIRED MULTIPLE ROUNDS STRIKING ONE SUSPECT IN THE ARM AND THE SECOND SUSPECT IN THE SHOULDER.

THE TWO INJURED SUSPECTS WERE TAKEN TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WHERE THEIR INJURIES WERE DETERMINED TO BE NON LIFE THREATENING. ALL FOUR SUSPECTS WERE TAKEN INTO CUSTODY.
