SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING AN OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING, THAT OCCURRED THURSDAY, MARCH 18, 2010, IN THE 11300 BLOCK OF VIRGINIA AVENUE, LYNWOOD.

DETECTIVES LEARNED THAT OFFICERS FROM THE SOUTH GATE POLICE DEPARTMENT RESPONDED TO AN ARMED ROBBERY THAT HAD JUST OCCURRED. A CRIME BROADCAST WAS PUT OUT WITH A DESCRIPTION OF THE SUSPECTS AND THEIR VEHICLE. AS OFFICERS SEARCHED THE AREA, THEY SAW A VEHICLE, MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION OF THE SUSPECT'S VEHICLE, DRIVING SOUTHBOUND ON ATLANTIC BOULEVARD FROM MARTIN LUTHER KING BOULEVARD, LYNWOOD. OFFICERS INITIATED A TRAFFIC STOP IN THE 11300 BLOCK OF VIRGINIA AVENUE, LYNWOOD. WHEN THE VEHICLE STOPPED, OFFICERS GAVE ORDERS TO THE DRIVER BUT, HE DID NOT COMPLY AND INSTEAD, EXITED THE VEHICLE, AND AN OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING OCCURRED.

THE MALE DRIVER WAS WOUNDED BY GUNFIRE AND IS BEING TREATED AT A LOCAL HOSPITAL. THE MALE PASSENGER WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT.

NO OFFICERS WERE INJURED.

TWO LOADED HANDGUNS WERE RECOVERED AT THE SCENE.
