Narrative:

Deputies responded to a trespassing call at the location, which is a vacant house. They detained the suspects and cleared the house for additional suspects. The deputies found evidence of a sophisticated psilocybin ("magic mushrooms") growing operation. The deputies notified Narcotics Bureau, who in turn notified L.A. County Health Hazmat, due to the possibility of toxic spores present in the house. Several firearms were also found during the search of the location.

The suspects were booked at Lancaster Station and are being held on several charges, including burglary, cultivation of psilocybin, and receiving stolen property.
