Narrative:

On Thursday, March 18, deputies from Lomita Sheriff's Station responded to Mira Catalina Elementary School in Rancho Palos Verdes after a 10-year-old student claimed a male adult attempted to abduct her from the campus. During the course of the investigation Sheriff's Department detectives learned that the alleged victim fabricated the entire story.

Reasons for the fabricated story will remain private, but the young girl has expressed remorse for what she did. The Sheriff's Department will be working closely with officials from the Palos Verdes School District and Mira Catalina Elementary School to address all issues associated with this incident. We anticipate no criminal charges will be filed.
